The following are the specific rules that apply: **NOTE: A COACH, PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF THE GAME, SHOULD DETERMINE IF THE TEAM USING THE CLUB GUEST PLAYER IS COMPLYING WITH CLUB GUEST PLAYER RULES. BECAUSE A REFEREE MIGHT NOT BE AWARE OF THESE RULES, BRING A COPY TO EACH MATCH**

1. A team may use in any league game up to two club guest players. A club guest player must be rostered to a team within the club of the team for which he/she is guest playing, must be age appropriate, and the team to which the club guest player is rostered must be playing that season in the CUSL league, MVYSA or Premier divisions of BPYSL.

2. A player rostered to a first division team may not guest play for a team in its own age group that competes in a less competitive division. A player rostered to a First Division team may only guest play on an older team in his/her club that plays in First or Second Division. A player not rostered to a First Division team, can not guest play for a team in any age group that is more than two lesser competitive divisions than the division in which the team to which the club guest player is rostered plays. A player rostered to a BPYSL premier division can only guest play in CUSL Div 1 or 2. A player rostered in MVYSA must follow CUSL rules above, with respect to within 2 divisions.

3. A U8 player may guest on a U8 or U9 team, only.

4. A U9 player may guest on a U9, U10 or U11 team, only.

5. In U-14 and younger ages, a player rostered to an older team cannot guest play on a younger team.

6. A club guest player cannot play in more than two games a day, and must have at least the time equivalent of a one game break between games in which he/she plays.

7. A club guest player must honor the commitment to the team to which he/she is rostered, and is not permitted to miss any part of the game of their rostered team in order to guest play.

8. Including club guest players, a team cannot dress more than the maximum number of players that can be rostered in the team's age. A coach cannot tell a rostered player to miss a game in order to use a club guest player.

9. Before the game begins, the coach who is using a club guest player must notify the Referee and opposing coach he/she is doing so, and give the opposing coach a completed Club Guest Player Information Sheet, which form is available on the Rules Guide link on the CUSL website. In the absence of this form, the player cannot guest. NOTE: Prior to the game means it can be given as late as the time the referee checks passes prior to the beginning of the game; it does not have to be given any sooner but it should be given early enough so the opposing coach can review the Information Sheet and each guest player's pass without delaying the start of the game.

10. No club guest player is permitted to play in any game in which he/she does not have their player pass.

11. The uniform of a club guest player must be the same as the team for whom he/she is guesting.

12. A club guest player receiving a red card in a game in which he/she is guesting will serve the suspension in the next match(es) of the team to which he/she is rostered, and cannot guest play for another team during the period of suspension.

13. Violation of these rules shall be referred to the Conduct Committee.
